Gentlemen:

The present complement at Grass Valley consists of three Troublemen and one Utility Troubleman. The Utility Troubleman classification was established by agreement between Company and Union dated January 17, 1957. The Utility Troubleman classification performs the full duties of Troubleman and Gas Serviceman. At the time it was established, there were no full-time Servicemen at Grass Valley; and the gas system consisted of a small propane air mix plant and a small distribution system with practically no comsumer growth. Natural gas was subsequently extended to Grass Valley, and the present Gas Service Department at Grass Valley consists of one Serviceman and one Reserve Gas Serviceman.

Company has reviewed the gas service workload and concludes that the volume of gas service work performed by the Utility Troubleman does not warrant continuation of the classification. Therefore, Company proposes, pursuant to Section 204.4 of the Physical Agreement, to cancel the January 17, 1957 letter agreement establishing the Utility Troubleman classification at Grass Valley, and to reclassify the present incumbent to Troubleman concurrent with the cancellation of such Agreement.
