Gentlemen:

Mr. G. O. Johnson, Light Crew Foreman, Watsonville, has been on and off Worker's Compensation since he sustained an industrial injury on July 11, 1978. In an attempt to rehabilitate Mr. Johnson, Company proposes, pursuant to Sections 205.19 and 206.12 of the Physical Agreement, to place Mr. Johnson in a Light Crew Foreman position in Santa Cruz for a 12 month period beginning August 17, 1981. In this 12 month period, Mr. Johnson will be responsible for mark and locate work, which is in keeping with his physical restrictions.

This agreement is with the clear understanding that Mr. Johnson will not be entitled to any additional compensation, such as travel time, associated with the move. Furthermore, at the end of the 12 month period, Mr. Johnson may be required to return to his base classification at Watsonville.

This proposal has been discussed with IBEW Business Representative Robert L. Thomson and has his concurrence.
