## Gentlemen:

The hours of work of the Division Substation Maintenance crews headquarted in Stockton are currently from 7:30 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. with a lunch break from 11:30 a.m. to 12:00 noon. This schedule, unless changed by Agreement, will remain stationary until August 1, 1982, on which date these crews will again report to normal work hours of 8:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. Changes from 7:30 a.m. to 8:00 a.m. and vice versa will occur on August 1 each year thereafter. This is in accordance with an agreement between Company and Union affecting all employees in maintenance, operation, and construction at 4040 West Lane, Stockton.

To better coordinate with Stockton maintenance crews, Company proposes, pursuant to Section 202.16 of the Physical Agreement, that the maintenance crew at Telsa Substation be assigned the same hours of work as their counterparts in Stockton. Therefore, the crew at Telsa would work currently from 7:30 a.m. to 4:00 p.m., changing on August 1, 1982, to 8:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. Change will occur on August 1 in each subsequent year.

This proposal has been discussed with IBEW Business Representative Mickey Harrington and has his concurrence.
