Mr. Cole's physician has found Mr. Cole to be precluded from returning to the Serviceman classification. On May 12, 1981, Mr. Cole was returned to light duty and has been successfully performing the duties of a Relief Service Operator.

As East Bay Division has recently established a Relief Service Operator position in Fremont, Company proposes to place Mr. Cole into this position pursuant to Section 205.19 of the Physical Agreement. This placement is made with the understanding that Mr. Cole will not be required to perform heavy work, e.g., bending, stooping, lifting, climbing, pushing, pulling, on a continuing basis.

Company further proposes, pursuant to Section 205.19 of the Physical Agreement, to place Mr. Cole into the next available Service Operator position in the Hayward or Fremont headquarters.

It is our understanding that this entire proposal has the concurrence of Mr. Wayne Greer, Union Business Representative serving East Bay Division.
