Gentlemen:

As a result of a non-industrial, degenerative hip condition, Mr. H. G. Stokes, Field Meterman, Gas Production, Rio Vista, Sacramento Division, has been on Long Term Disability since August 1, 1981. On February 23, 1982, Dr. George E. Sims, orthopedist, examined Mr. Stokes and recommended that he would be able to return to work in a sedentary position. On March 24, 1982, Mr. Stokes' personal physician, Dr. William P. Murray, concurred with Dr. Sims.

Therefore, pursuant to Section 112.15 of the Physical Agreement, Company proposes to return Mr. Stokes from Long Term Disability to active service as an Assistant Foreman's Clerk, Yolo District, District Electric Department, Woodland, Sacramento Division, effective June 28, 1982. Mr. Stokes will be paid at the top rate of \$465.15 per week. There will be no moving or commute expenses as a result of his return to regular status.

It is our understanding that this proposal has been discussed with Mr. P. Zimmerman, Union Business Representative serving Sacramento Division, and has his concurrence.
