In continuance, another problem has arised for me. I send my son to a school and babby sitter durning the days, but now durning the evenings I have no one to watch him, and must be home nights.


In conclusion, I as his father must be home to fufill my parent responsiblity, which I am sure I need not go into detail of parent responsiblity and love of our children.
