Gentlemen:

The current language of the Gas Serviceman Training and Reserve Gas Serviceman Agreement with regard to selection of the qualified pre-bidder who will attend the next scheduled session of the school, is extremely cumbersome to administer and has contributed to long delays in the filling of vacancies.

In order to provide a more manageable procedure, Company proposes to amend Section B.1.(a) of the Letter Agreement, dated November 20, 1979, to read as follows:

"Prebids

The (final) selection of the qualified prebidder, who will attend the next scheduled session of the school, will be made as soon after the vacancy occurs as possible but in no case less than two weeks prior to the beginning of the school. Upon successful completion of the school, the employee shall be awarded the vacancy effective the following Monday."
