The present hours of work for Mr. B. Willis are 7:30 a.m. to 12:00 p.m. and 12:30 p.m. to 4:00 p.m. The proposed hours are 8:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m. and 12:30 p.m. to 4:30 p.m.

These proposed changes will be in effect for the above named employees only, and relief will be accomplished during the regular hours of 7:30 a.m. to 12:00 p.m. and 12:30 p.m. to 4:00 p.m. By starting earlier, the T&D Driver will be able to load tools, equipment, and minor materials prior to the arrival of crews, thereby increasing productivity. Shifting the Inspector's hours will enable him to brief the Field Line Foreman in the morning and afternoon when they are not involved with the crews.

While this proposed change in hours is to be on a permanent basis, both Company and Union shall retain the right to cancel this Agreement with thirty (30) days written notice to that effect.
