Gentlemen:

Company and Union have recently discussed the rate per mile paid to employees under Section 201.10 of the Physical Agreement, common carrier rate. Company has reviewed this matter and proposes to increase the mileage allowance to 12 cents per mile in accordance with the following:

For the purpose of reimbursement of transportation expenses in those situations where the employee does not utilize the arrangements provided in Sections 201.7, 201.8(a), or 201.9 of the Physical Agreement, employees shall be reimbursed at the rate of 12 cents per mile. Furthermore, the same rate of 12 cents per mile shall be used in transportation of employees on temporary assignment under the provisions of Subsection 201.2(b).

This increase reflects adjustments in the common carrier rate made by the State Department of Transportation.
