Gentlemen:

As a result of the 1983 General Negotiations, Company proposes to amend Paragraph G11 of the Master Apprenticeship Agreement to read as follows:

G.11 Training of Apprentices

An employee is entitled to two opportunities to participate in (an) apprenticeship training program(s). His or her subsequent bid to fill a job vacancy in an apprentice classification will not receive consideration under the provisions of Title 205. However, an apprentice who suffers a disability which precludes his or her return to that same apprenticeship shall be given one additional opportunity to participate in an apprenticeship provided his or her previous disability would not prohibit such participation.

All cases shall be referred to the Apprenticeship Committee for review before placement is made.

Notwithstanding the above, an employee who has exercised his or her two opportunities to participate in an apprenticeship prior to September 1, 1983, shall be allowed one additional opportunity to participate in an apprenticeship.

If a journeyman in either the Electric Maintenance Department or the Steam Generation Maintenance Department bids to the apprenticeship of the other, such move shall not constitute one of the two opportunities to enter an apprenticeship.

If you are in accord with the foregoing and agree thereto, please so indicate in the space provided below and return one executed copy of this letter to the Company.
