We propose to establish Meter Reader route assignments in a manner different than that set forth in the Meter Reader Agreement for nine offices in North Bay Division. This proposal is based on a majority vote by the Meter Readers in these offices.

The specific methods the nine local offices will utilize in rotating route strings are as follows: Rotate every six months, Lakeport; rotate every three months, San Rafael; rotate every two months, Mill Valley; rotate monthly will be Sonoma, Healdsburg, Ukiah, Silverado, Novato and Petaluma.
