Gentlemen:

Bay District of East Bay Division currently has a vacant Senior Meterman position in Richmond which the Division has been unable to fill through the job bidding procedure.

The Company proposes, pursuant to Section 205.19 of the Physical Agreement, to appoint Mr. Edward R. Bunten, Apprentice Meterman, Concord, to fill this position. Mr. Bunten is currently at the two-year progression step, with approximately five months remaining before completing his apprenticeship. He will be subject to all requirements set forth in his training guidelines and the Master Apprenticeship Agreement which he has yet to complete. Failure to complete the apprenticeship will be cause for removal from this classification. Upon successful completion of the 30-month Meterman apprenticeship, his status will change to permanent. This matter has been discussed with local union representatives.
