Gentlemen:

Pursuant to Section 18.17 of the Clerical Agreement, Company proposes to effect the placement of Ms. Janet Powell, Service Representative, Customer Services, Concord, into a vacant Utility Clerk position in the Concord Electric Department.

Ms. Powell is currently on the Workers' Compensation payroll subsequent to her being medically precluded from returning to a customercontact position. Under this proposal, Ms. Powell will initially be placed in the Utility Clerk position for a period of three months to determine suitability. Accordingly, during this period, she will maintain her current wage rate.

Subsequent to the expiration of this three-month period, if 'Company determines that Ms. Powell is able to successfully fulfill the requirements of this position, she will be premanently placed at the wage rate of \$477.10 per week as is provided for pursuant to Subsection 7.10(b)(3) of the Clerical Agreement (Ms. Powell has twelve years of Company service). Such permanent placement shall be predicated on a permanent and stationary rating for Ms. Powell's disability.

Additionally, subsequent to Ms. Powell's permanent placement as a Utility Clerk, she retains Section 19.9 "a" rights back to her previous classification without reference to the provisions of Section 18.10 of the Clerical Agreement, at such time as her medical preclusions are removed.
