To assist the Materials Department in moving to the new warehouse facility in Fremont, the Company will temporarily utilize the services of Helpers obtained from the Civil-Hydro Department. The temporary employees will be paid at the appropriate Materialsman rate. The temporary assignments are expected to extend to the end of this year. The number will vary from 8 to 15 temporary classifications.

Because of the expected duration of the work, we propose that such appointments will not be limited to the 20-day upgrade provisions of Section 305.4.
