## Gentlemen:

It has been determined that adequate provision can be made for maintenance of specialized communication equipment in General Office, at least for the time being, on a basis other than the present rotating shift arrangement negotiated on December 8, 1970.

Accordingly, in order to eliminate the 1600 to midnight shift, Company proposes, pursuant to Subsection 202.16(b) of the Physical Agreement, to establish the following rotating shifts in addition to the present 0800 - 1700 Monday through Friday shift, the 0800 - 1700 Tuesday through Saturday shift, and the 0730 - 1600 Monday through Friday shift:

- (1) An additional rotating shift for the hours 0730 1100, 1100 1130 lunch, 1130 1600 (Monday through Friday).
- (2) An additional rotating Tuesday through Saturday shift for every fourth week (0800 1200, 1200 1300 lunch, 1300 1700).

A typical schedule for General Office Technicians is indicated in the attached schedule.

If additional Technicians are added to the work force, our schedule will be extended to provide a rotating schedule commensurate with the number of Technicians.

The elimination of the swing shift is based upon the present ability to maintain the communication equipment during the above shifts. It may, however, become necessary in the future to reschedule a swing shift should conditions change.

If you are in accord with the foregoing and the attachment and agree thereto, please so indicate in the space provided below and return one executed copy of this letter to Company.
