Gentlemen:

Company proposes, pursuant to Section 206.12 of the Physical Agreement, to place Mr. Don Hansen in a Routine Transmission Mechanic position at Tracy. Mr. Hansen is a former Stanpac employee who was transferred from Los Banos to Tracy as a Mechanic-Welder. He recently failed to qualify on the welding certification tests and was therefore demoted from the Mechanic-Welder position to a Pipe Line Mechanic position on January 2, 1985. We would like to afford Mr. Hansen the same opportunity as other former Stanpac employees to become qualified as a Transmission Mechanic in Pipe Line Operations.

We propose that Mr. Hansen be placed at the first wage step of Routine Transmission Mechanic, effective the date on which this Letter of Agreement is fully executed. We further propose that he progress at six-month intervals, providing he meets the training requirements, with the exception that his wage progression shall not be withheld should the required training not be made available.
