The Company proposes, pursuant to Subsection 202.16(b) of the Physical Agreement, that the hours of work of the Gas Transmission and Distribution employees headquartered in Fremont be permanently changed to 7:00 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. They are currently working 7:30 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. This change would become effective once the agreement has been signed.

The permanent change in hours is proposed to reduce the congestion in the yard during departure and arrival times. The employees are in accord with this change in hours.
