Following a three-year validation study by the Edison Electric Institute of selection requirements for System Operators and Power Dispatchers, Company has changed the pre-employment entry requirements by adding two tests. The two new tests are the EAS #6 - Numerical Reasoning with a passing score of 7 and the EAS #7 - Verbal Reasoning with a score of 6. Both tests were shown to be job-related according to the Federal Uniform Guidelines on Employee Selection Procedures (1978).

Pursuant to Subsection 205.11(b) of the Physical Agreement, Company proposes that anyone seeking to enter the Operator-in-Training or System Operator classifications through the bidding or transfer procedures be required to pass the Operator-in-Training pre-employment examination consisting of the following tests and cut-off scores:
