Gentlemen:

The Company proposes, pursuant to Section 7.15 and Subsection 7.10(b)(2) of the Clerical Agreement, to return Mr. David Ray from Long Term Disability to active service as a Utility Clerk-Operating in Bakersfield. Mr. Ray's employment date is February 17, 1983.

Mr. Ray sustained a knee injury on February 24, 1984. Due to the extent of his injury, he was unable to return to work and perform the duties of his regular classification of Meter Reader. The Company was unable to place him in another position and he was therefore placed on Long Term Disability effective August 11, 1984. On February 15, 1985 Mr. Ray was re-evaluated by his physician, and it was determined that Mr. Ray is not capable of performing the duties of a Meter Reader without significant risk of reinjury.

The Utility Clerk-Operating position is within Mr. Ray's physical ability, and there is currently a vacancy in this classification in Bakersfield.

Mr. Ray concurs with this placement, and this matter has been discussed with Mr. Wayne Weaver, Union Business Representative.
