As a result of the establishment of (1151) Mainman-Arc classification, Company proposes to revise Exhibit VI, Division Gas Transmission and Distribution lines of progression to include the classification wherever the (1150) Steam Mainman appears.

Company further proposes to first move the Steam Mainman from its position under "Next Lower Classifications" to the designation of "Same or Higher Classifications" in the following cases: (0561) Apprentice Fitter; (0524) Fieldman and (0419) Truck Driver.

Company also proposes to move the (0524) Fieldman to "Same or Higher" in the Apprentice Fitter lines of progression and the Fieldman and the (0240) Field Clerk to "Same or Higher" in the (0419) Truck Driver lines of progression.

In addition to these changes, Company proposes to delete the (2089) Assistant Gas Repairman and (2087) Gas Repairman job definitions from Exhibit VI and these classifications from all other Exhibit VI lines of progression. Both of these "San Francisco only" classifications were designated incumbent only and are now vacant.
