#### Gentlemen:

Pursuant to Section 10.7 of the Clerical Agreement, Company proposes to re-establish an eight-hour day, five-day workweek schedule at the Fairfield Computer Center. This schedule will be used in conjunction with the current 12-hour-day work schedule. The eight-hour-day work schedule is required because of a reduction in the workload on the third shift and on the weekends. This has occurred by the consolidation of two major computer systems into one system which is capable of completing the workload in a much shorter time.

This proposal is a modification to Letter Agreement 84-116-PGE which was signed by the Union on May 14, 1985.

#### 12-Hour-Day Schedule

The Computer Operations Department will maintain the current 12-hourshift schedule for 12 bargaining unit employees who will be divided into four teams. Each team will consist of a Senior Computer Operator and two Computer Operator I's. These employees will work the same schedule that is currently worked by the Senior Computer Operators with the same work hours. Senior Computer Operators and Computer Operator I's must have successfully completed all their required training to work on the 12-hour-day shift.

#### 8-Hour-Day Schedule

The remaining 12 bargaining unit employees will move to an eight-hourday shift schedule comprised of a first and second shift.

A first and second shift will be established with a Monday-Friday workweek. There will be seven positions on the first shift and five positions on the second shift. Computer Operator I's may work on the eight-hour-day shift providing all the 12-hour-day positions are filled. Initial Shift Assignment

Both shifts (8 and 12) will be filled by Company seniority. All Senior Computer Operators and Computer Operator I's must have successfully completed all required training before they can continue on, or be assigned to, the 12-hour shift. Trained Computer Operator I's may work on the eight-hour shift providing all 12-hour-day positions are filled.

Attached is the 12-hour-day workweek schedule and also attached is the eight-hour-day workweek schedule. The third attachment is the Computer Operations Department seniority list at the Fairfield Computer Center.
