The Company proposes, pursuant to Subsection 10.7(b) of the Clerical Agreement, to change the hours of the Operations Unit employees in the Receivables Accounting Section of the Customer Accounting Department. The Company has purchased four new processing machines which will allow the Unit to operate with one 14-hour shift. The present 24-hour operation will change to a 14-hour operation under this proposal. There are now 3 shifts in the Unit, and the Company proposes to eliminate the second and third shifts. The three affected functions of the Unit will have new and separate start times.
