Gentlemen:

Pursuant to Letter Agreement 86-94-PGE, the Company proposes to extend the pilot ten-hour, four-day workweek schedule at the Fremont Gas Meter Repair Plant.

The pilot was implemented October 20, 1986 and is scheduled to end on December 26, 1986. The Company proposes to extend the pilot to June 30, 1987, at which time a decision will be made concerning adoption of the new schedule on a regular basis. The extension will provide time to more fully evaluate the ten-hour, four-day workweek. The terms of the initial September 18, 1986 letter of agreement will remain in effect during the extension period.
