Gentlemen:

The Company proposes, pursuant to Section 205.19 of the Physical Agreement, to permanently place Mr. Jon V. Henrie into the position of Inspector in the Antioch Headquarters of East Bay Region.

Mr. Henrie was employed by the Company on October 3, 1961. On July 27, 1967, Mr. Henrie sustained an industrial injury while working as a Lineman. The injury resulted in the amputation of both arms. On January 29, 1971, Mr. Henrie returned to work as a Engineering Assistant-Electric and was permanently placed in the classification on January 1, 1973. On December 16, 1981, Mr. Henrie encountered problems with his prosthetic devices and was returned to the Workers' Compensation Payroll.

On April 1, 1985, Mr. Henrie returned to work as an Inspector T/A on the Rehabilitation Payroll in order to train him and evaluate his suitability for this type of work. He has satisfactorily performed the duties of this position; therefore, the Company proposes to place him as an Inspector.

Mr. Henrie will be paid at the Inspector rate of pay of \$648.50 per week.

This proposal has been discussed with Mr. Art Murray, Union Business Representative.
