Gentlemen:

The Company proposes, pursuant to Subsection 10.7(b) of the Clerical Agreement, to change the working hours of the temporary Service Representative-Steno working with the gas and electric estimating group in the Livermore headquarters of East Bay Region.

The normal hours of work are from 8:00 a.m. through 5:00 p.m. The proposed hours of work are from 7:30 a.m. through 4:30 p.m. These hours are currently being worked on a temporary basis pursuant to a local agreement.

The change of work hours is being requested to provide telephone coverage between 7:30 a.m. and 8:00 a.m. when it is needed. The other estimating employees start work between 7:00 a.m. and 7:30 a.m. All calls come in through a switchboard and must be transferred by the Service Representative-Steno.

The employee currently in the temporary Service Representative-Steno position, Gail Huffman, concurs with this proposal.

The proposal has been discussed with Mr. Bob Choate, Union Business Representative.
