The Company proposes, pursuant to Section 112.15 of the Physical Agreement, to permanently place Mr. Pete Torres into the position of Operator Mechanic at the McDonald Island Gas Storage Facility.

Mr. Torres worked as an Apprentice Gas Control Mechanic. In September 1982, he went on Long Term Disability due to a nonindustrial accident.
