Mr. Cates:

I would like to request that I be transferred as close to the Fresno area as possible, due to my wifes medical condition. She is and has been under the care of Dr. B.P. Lau as explained in the attached letter from Dr. Lau. My wife is required to visit the doctor and hospital at least twice per month for check ups and laboratory tests. More often as conditions may require.

I am presently working for Mr. E.G. Sharon in the Station Construction Department at Foothill Sub, in San Luis Obisbo, a distance of approximatley 135 miles from my residence at 2498 S. Madera Ave., Kerman. Due to the long distance from my home to the jobsite I am unable to commute. This means that I cannot be with my wife to assist her in obtaining the required medical attention she needs. During the last year my sister-in-law has been staying with us to help my wife while I am not at home. I am away from home five days a week and home only on the week-ends. My sister-in-law will no longer be able to stay with us, and my wife will now have to be by herself.

On October 7, 1971, Mr. R.E. Markey, Mr. J.A. Cates, Mr. R.R. Powell, Mr. E.G. Sharon, Mr. R. Storrey (Local Union 1245) and myself had a conference at Mr. Powell's office in Fresno to discuss a change in my classification. At this time I presented them with the fact that my family was sick and that I would be required to be with them during their illness, and that if possible I would like to be stationed as close to my home as could be, due to the hardships created by my families condition. I was in or around the Fresno area for approximatley a year and a half. During this time the doctors thought they had my wifes illness cured. Since that time my wifes condition has changed and the doctors believe she is having a re-occurance of Cancer, and that she will need assistance in every possible way.
