Gentlemen:

In 1968, when the Measurement and Control Group in Pipe Line Operations was reorganized, Mr. C. A. Townsend was reclassified from Meter Subforeman to Gas Transmission Technician at McDonald Island. The requirement for a 2nd Class License was waived. Since this time the work at McDonald Island has become more complex.

Mr. Townsend's experience is primarily with meters and regulators and other pneumatic equipment and can be more effectively employed at the Antioch headquarters. In addition, Mr. Townsend has had some health problems, including chronic glaucoma, which have affected his attendance and availability for emergency work. Accordingly, Company proposes to transfer Mr. Townsend to a Gas Transmission Technician position in Antioch, pursuant to Sections 205.19 and 206.13 of the Physical Agreement.
