Gentlemen:

The following proposal is based upon discussions between Company and Union committees concerning the potential consolidation of the Chico and Paradise Service Centers in De Sabla Division. As a result of those discussions Company proposes, pursuant to Section 205.19 of the Physical Agreement to institute a trial consolidation of the Paradise and Chico Service Centers in De Sabla Division from June 1, 1987 to December 31, 1987. For purposes of this trial the following conditions are applicable.

- 1. The Chico and Paradise Districts will be considered as one single service area, without any boundary between the districts.
- 2. All employees, except as noted in A below, currently headquartered at the Paradise Service Center will report to the Chico Service Center effective June 1, 1987.
 - A. The two Gas Servicemen and the two senior Troublemen will continue to report to the Paradise Service Center.
 - B. All employees will retain their current "base" position wage rate for the duration of the trial. This does not preclude changes to the base position or wage rate through normal bidding or transfer activities or from changes not resulting from this trial.
 - C. All employees at Paradise will be paid travel time and mileage as provided in Sections 202.23 and 201.6 of the Physical Agreement each day they report to their "temporary headquarters" in Chico. Each employee will report his/her one way mileage and driving time to the supervisor no later than the second day after reporting to Chico. If there is any question about the mileage, a supervisor and shop steward will make the drive to confirm the distance and/or time.

- D. Any employee who would qualify for a moving allowance under Subsection 206.8, if the consolidation becomes a permanent move at the conclusion of this trial, will be given the moving package to which they would be entitled if the move were permanent on June 1, 1987.
- 3. The Gas Servicemen remaining in Paradise will continue to work the same schedule as they currently work.
- 4. The two Troublemen remaining in Paradise will work a ten days on, four days off schedule, with the days off being Saturday, Sunday, Monday and Tuesday.
- 5. At the consolidated Chico and Paradise Service Center the least senior Troubleman will be assigned to the "ladder wagon" and do the work normally done by a lineman working alone. This employee will continue to receive Troubleman's pay.
- 6. The seniority lists for both groups will be consolidated to a single list as shown in Attachment 1.
- 7. The pre-arranged overtime list for both groups will be consolidated. This will be done by combining the lists with each person retaining their actual accumulated hours on the new list. See Attachment 2, which is included for illustration purposes. The actual hours will be computed to include all hours accumulated through the day prior to consolidation.
- 8. The emergency overtime list for both groups will be consolidated by the same method as the pre-arranged overtime. See Attachment 3 which is included for illustration purposes. The actual hours will be computed to include all hours accumulated through the day prior to consolidation.
- 9. All upgrades will be by seniority from one list for all employees except the Troublemen. In the Troubleman classification, the following procedure will be used:
 - A. The first opportunity for upgrade in either Chico or Paradise will go to the Troubleman from Paradise who is relocated to Chico.
 - B. When the individual designated above is already doing Troubleman work or is unavailable, upgrades to Troubleman will be given by seniority from the Paradise list for Paradise and the Chico list for Chico. If all qualified individuals on a list are exhausted, the list from the other headquarters will be used.
- 10. Remote reporting, pursuant to Subsection 202.21, shall be conducted for the entire service area within the boundaries of Chico and Paradise Districts.

- A. No employee will receive both an expense allowance under Subsection 202.21 and an expense allowance under Subsection 202.23 for the same day.
- 11. The travel time accumulated by those Paradise employees who are reporting to the Chico Service Center as a temporary headquarters will not be counted as pre-arranged overtime, except in those cases where there is other pre-arranged overtime involved. (Arbitration Case 14 supports this position.)
- 12. The mileage owed to the Paradise employees reporting to Chico would be paid on the Monday after each regular payday for the prior payperiod by a local check. Such mileage is not believed to be taxable income.
