Pursuant to Sections 205.19 and 206.12 of the Physical Agreement, Company proposes to place Mr. Roger Dunning (Hire Date: 2-26-62) into a Utility Clerk position in Diablo Division, Antioch.

Mr. Dunning was formerly an Equipment Operator in Diablo Division, Antioch. On March 6, 1981, he sustained an industrial injury to his back which rendered him incapable of performing physical classification work. Consequently, he was placed on Worker's Compensation Payroll.

On July 31, 1986, Mr. Dunning was placed on the Rehabilitation Payroll as a Utility Clerk T/A for the purposes of training and evaluating his ability to perform this type of work.
