Letter Agreement 87-19-PGE established procedures for the displacement and relocation of several Sacramento Garage employees.

Per Item 3. of the letter agreement, the individual filling the Garageman-Building position in the Sacramento Regional Headquarters - day shift, would also be required to perform Building Helper duties.

This position was filled by Mr. Mike J. Moreno. Mr. Moreno has requested that the position be reclassified to Building Helper. He is aware that reclassification would result in a decrease in his hourly rate of pay.

In response to this request, the Company proposes to change the classification of this position to Building Helper, effective with the signing of this agreement.

The incumbent will continue to be required to perform Garageman duties, as necessary. The position will be paid at the Helper rate of pay; however, when performing Garageman duties, the employee will be paid at the Garageman rate, pursuant to Section 204.3 of the Physical Agreement.

When this position becomes vacant, the Company will review the position to determine the appropriate classification.
