Gentlemen:

Pursuant to Subsections 202.16(b) and 202.21(d) of the Physical Agreement, Company proposes to amend Application No. 1 of Section 202.21 to include eight Region Electric Transmission and Substation positions headquartered in Concord. The proposed remote reporting site would be Contra Costa Substation (Antioch) for approximately six months, provided that operational needs continue for such duration.

The classifications needed are:

- 1 - Electrical Technician
- 6 - Electricians
- 1 - Apprentice Electrician

This proposed action is necessary to improve efficiency and productivity. Company intends to begin remote reporting within one week of the execution of this Letter Agreement. Either party may cancel this agreement upon giving 30 days' notice.

This matter has been discussed with Art Murray, Union Business Representative.
