Company proposes pursuant to Section 205.19 of the Physical Agreement to appoint R.F. Heywood to a "Provisional" Electrician, Midway, San Joaquin Valley Region. Mr. Heywood is currently a fifth step Apprentice Electrician who transferred from General Construction on June 13, 1988. Mr. Heywood is the only interested bidder to the Midway Electrician position.
