## Gentlemen:

Company established a dual classification of Helper/Meter Reader in Ridgecrest on December 29, 1975. Mr. Kurt A. Becker, a new hire, was placed in that new beginning level position. In December 1981, Company no longer had a need for a dual Helper/Meter Reader at that location and reclassified Mr. Becker to Meter Reader. This unilateral action removed Mr. Becker from the Gas T&D line of progression and placed him in the line of progression to Customer Services classifications.

Company, therefore, proposes, pursuant to Section 205.19, to obtain agreement to grant Mr. Becker Subsection 205.7(b) rights to the Fieldman classification at the Ridgecrest headquarters.
