Gentlemen:

The Company proposes, pursuant to Section 202.21 of the Physical Agreement, to extend remote reporting at Contra Costa Substation in Antioch, East Bay Region, for six months, provided that operational needs continue for such duration. Remote reporting was originally established at this location under Letter Agreement 87-89.

For the period of this extension, the Company would utilize one Electrical Technician and two Electricians. Assignments would be made in accordance with the provisions set forth in Section 202.21 of the Agreement.

It is further proposed that either party may cancel this agreement by giving the other party 30 days written notice of their intent to do so.

It is our understanding that this has been reviewed with Mr. Joe Valentino, Union Business Representative.
