Gentlemen:

The Company proposes, pursuant to Note 1 of Section 202.21 of the Physical Agreement, to establish remote reporting at the Moraga Substation in the East Bay Region for a period of six months, provided that operational needs continue for such duration.

Under this proposal, two Transmission and Substation Electricians would be utilized. Assignments would be made in accordance with the provisions set forth in Section 202.21 of the Agreement.

It is further proposed that either party may cancel this agreement by giving the other party 30 days written notice of their intent to do so.

It is our understanding that this proposal has been discussed with Mr. Joe Valentino, Union Business Representative.
