Gentlemen:

The Company proposes, pursuant to Subsection 24.1(a) of the Clerical Agreement and Letter Agreement 86-85, to extend the assignment of Mr. Jeff Carter, an agency employee in the Santa Rosa office of Redwood Region, for a period of nine and one-half weeks beyond six months.

Mr. Carter has been relieving for Ms. Joan Elizabeth Brenner who is a Meter Reader. Ms. Brenner has been off on a maternity and child care leave and is scheduled to return to work on May 23, 1988. Mr. Carter will have concluded six months of his assignment with PG&E as of March 17, 1988. Rather than hire and train another agency employee to fill this gap, the Company prefers to continue using the current agency employee.
