As a result of discussions held between Mr. Darrel Mitchell of the IBEW staff and Mr. David Bergman of this department, and pursuant to Sections 205.19 and 206.12, Company proposes the following:

An employee who is displaced, either from an apprenticeship or to another headquarters as an apprentice, pursuant to the provisions of Title 206, and who eventually becomes a Journeyman by completing the same apprenticeship, shall have Subsection 205.7(a) bidding rights to that Journeyman position at the headquarters from which the employee was displaced.

These rights shall be in addition to Subsection 205.7(a) rights to the apprenticeship or lower classification at the headquarters from which the employee was displaced.
