## 4. HOURS

Overtime compensation will not be paid for the initial change to the 12-hour schedule.

## 5. SICK LEAVE, VACATION AND HOLIDAYS

Sick leave, vacation, and holiday entitlements for Pressure Operators will be in accordance with Letter Agreement 86-89.

Sick leave, vacation and holiday entitlements for Relief Pressure Operators will be converted to hours and will be charged according to the number of hours scheduled to work. Any hours of entitlement less than eight hours will be carried over to the next calendar year with the exception of Bonus vacation which must be used during the calendar year.

The six fixed holidays determined by a vote of the employees are:

1. New Years Day - January 1
2. Memorial Day - Last Monday in May
3. Independence Day - July 4
4. Labor Day - First Monday in September
5. Thanksgiving Day - 4th Thursday in November
6. Christmas Day - December 25

This proposal has been discussed with Ed Caruso, Union Business Representative.
