The specifics of the program are:

- A. The service center will be divided into five groups:
 - 1. Auto Shop
 - 2. Tool Repair
 - 3. Warehouse
 - 4. Office
 - 5. Night Shift
- B. On a monthly basis, the above group with the lowest average sick leave hours used per employee will receive the equivalent of a \$5 award credited to the employees as a group. The average sick leave hours will be determined by the number of sick leave hours in the group divided by the number of employees in the group in that period.
- C. The award amount may not be taken in cash, but may be utilized for personalized items or lunches. Also, it may be distributed monthly, per Item B, at the end of the year, to be determined by each group.
- D. In case of first place ties, both groups will receive the \$5 award credit.

This agreement would allow Davis Service Center to provide the above award on a trial basis for 1988 only.
