Gentlemen:

Mr. Guillermo A. Velez, a Groundman in San Francisco Division, Golden Gate Region, has requested a leave of absence to complete his Associate of Arts Degree. In order to comply with the request, San Francisco Division would have to hire a relief behind Mr. Velez, who would possibly gain regular status under Title 106.

Because San Francisco Division does not have the flexibility to increase its headcount requirement and because of restrictions imposed by Letter Agreement 88-104, there would be a problem upon Mr. Velez's return.

Company, therefore, proposes that agreement be reached to waive the provisions of Letter Agreement 88-104, for the purpose of returning Mr. Velez to work. In the event that contracting does exist, and the relief employee has attained regular status, the impacted employee would exercise rights under the provisions of Title 206.

This proposal has been discussed with Mr. Ed Caruso, Union Business Representative.
