Gentlemen:

Pursuant to Step Five of Title 102 of the Physical Agreement, Review Committee Case No. 1682 was referred to Ad Hoc Negotiations by letter dated April 25, 1989. The unresolved issue in Ad Hoc No. 89-4 concerns the impact on IBEW represented employees resulting from conversion to the Ponderosa Phone Company at Helms. A previous agreement concerning phones was rendered void by the CPUC granting jurisdiction for phone service to Ponderosa.

On August 30, 1989, an Ad Hoc Committee met to resolve the issue. The Committee consisted of Rick Doering, Tom Phebus, Andy Euser, Bob Mooneyham, and Jim Greenhalgh for the Company; and Darrel Mitchell, Frank Hutchins, and Bill Wadman for the Union. The Committee agreed to the following to be effective September 1, 1989 for all incumbent IBEW represented employees headquartered at Helms on that date:

Company will pay all installation and/or transfer costs of one phone unit.

Company will pay the basic monthly service fee.

Company will pay an amount equivalent to the additional service "Double Rate" (\$17.10 per month).

At Company's option, it may elect to have the phone company direct bill the monthly service charge and additional service amount.

If Company elects not to be direct billed, employees will be reimbursed by the fifth day of the month for the previous month's entitlement.

If Company fails to reimburse employees by the fifth working day of the month, interest at the rate of 12% per annum will be paid on the outstanding amount.

All of the foregoing is predicated on employees signing up for and maintaining phone service with Ponderosa.

The Ad Hoc Committee is in agreement that the issue contained in Review Committee Case No. 1682 is resolved based on the foregoing and the case is considered closed.
