Gentlemen:

Pursuant to the provisions of Sections 205.19 and 112.10 of the Physical Agreement, Company proposes to place Mary Johnson as a Helper in the Sacramento Division Gas T&D Department.

Ms. Johnson sustained an industrial injury on November 18, 1987. As a result of this injury, she has been permanently precluded from returning to work as a Meter Reader for the current Meter Reader Supervisor. On September 6, 1988, Ms. Johnson was placed as a Helper T/A on the Rehabilitation Payroll to ascertain her ability to perform the duties of this position on a regular basis.

Her new rate of pay will be \$585.95 in accordance with the provisions of Subsection 112.10(c)(2) of the Physical Agreement. In addition, the time she spent working as a Helper T/A shall be counted towards the one year time in classification requirement for bidding purposes.

This proposal has been discussed with Wayne Greer, IBEW Business Representative.
