Company has recently completed a resurvey of the duties of the Utilityman classification at Potter Valley Powerhouse currently held by Mr. A. R. Willhite. As a result of this resurvey, Company proposes to reclassify this position to Utility Station Attendant at the wage rate of \$85.90 per week.

The proposed job definition for this classification is as follows:

Utility Station Attendant - Potter Valley Powerhouse

A resident employee who operates the power plant and its associated water facilities, checks equipment, performs minor maintenance work, regulates water and cleans spillways, grizzlies and his assigned work area.

This employee will accrue classification seniority as a Station Attendant.
