As a result of the conversion of Tule River Power House to semi-automatic operation and the resulting reduction in personnel at this location, Company has reevaluated the duties of the Utilityman portion of the Utilityman and Relief Station Attendant position, currently held by Mr. John Esheim, Jr. Company proposes to increase the wage rate of the Utilityman classification from \$79.20 to \$85.75 per week. The revised classification is composed of Electrician, Mechanic and Light Tractor Driver in equal parts.
