With completion of the first unit of Morro Bay Steam Plant scheduled for early spring of 1955, Company wishes to begin training operating employees next month. Company therefore proposes to establish the classifications of Senior Control Operator, Control Operator, Assistant Control Operator and Auxiliary Operator at Morro Bay Steam Plant. The duties will be the same as those of similar classifications at Kern and Moss Landing Steam Plants.
