Gentlemen:

Letter Agreement 89-151-PGE provides for the relocation of San Francisco Division, Electric Department, employees from the Martin Service Center to the new San Francisco Service Center. As a result of the Electric Construction employees' move, the workload for General Services employees located at Martin has shifted to the new Service Center.
