Gentlemen:

Pursuant to Subsection 202.16 (b) of the Physical Agreement, and Generic Letter Agreement 86-155-PGE, Company proposes to establish a 10-hour four-day workweek schedule for one Telecommunications Technician headquartered at McMaude Place. The effective date of this agreement will be the first Monday following the signing of this agreement by the Union and will continue for approximately six months.

The purpose of this change is to increase efficiencies in radio repair. The senior volunteer is Hank Spaletta and Hank will work this schedule for up to six months, at which point the Company will seek further volunteers and rotate those individuals through for six months periods. The proposal will follow the generic Agreement 86-155-PGE with the exception of the specific proposal outlined below.

The schedule for the participant will be from 7:00 a.m. to 17:30 p.m. with one half-hour for lunch. Either party may cancel this Agreement by providing one week's written notification.
