Gentlemen:

In accordance with the provisions of Subsection 202.16(b) of the Company/Union Agreement, Company proposes that the 4-day, 10-hour workweek schedule established by Letter Agreement 89-220-PGE for the Fresno Garage, Fresno Division, San Joaquin Valley Region, be extended for an additional six months. The current schedule, in effect until June 29, 1990, consists of two 4-day, 10-hour shift schedules. Day shift hours are 7:00 am - 12:00 noon and 12:30 pm - 5:30 pm. Night shift hours are 4:00 pm to 2:00 am. The workweek will begin on Monday and end on Friday.

This 4-day, 10-hour workweek schedule will follow the provisions of the Generic Four-Day, Ten-Hour workweek schedule (86-155-PGE) except for the following:

SCHEDULE

The proposed schedule will commence Monday, July 2, 1990, and will end on Friday, December 28, 1990.

This proposal has been discussed with the Local Business Representative. Either the Company or the Union reserves the right to return to the 5-day, 8-hour shift schedule by giving the other party 30 days advance written notice.

If you are in accord with the foregoing and agree thereto, please so indicate in the space provided below and return one executed copy of this letter to the Company.
