Gentlemen:

In accordance with the provisions of Subsection 202.16(b) of the Company/Union Agreement, Company proposes that the 4-day, 10-hour workweek schedule established by Letter Agreement 90-15-PGE for the Selma Garage, Eastside District, Fresno Division, San Joaquin Valley Region, be extended indefinitely. The current schedule, in effect until June 29, 1990, consists of 4-day, 10-hour shift schedules from 6:30 a.m. -11:30 a.m. and 12:00 p.m. - 5:00 p.m., beginning the first Monday in April and 7:30 a.m. - 12:30 p.m. and 1:00 p.m. - 6:00 p.m. during the winter months, beginning the first Monday in October. The workweek will begin on Monday and end on Saturday.

The 4-day, 10-hour workweek schedule will follow the provisions of the Generic Four-Day, Ten-Hour workweek schedule (86-155-PGE) except for the following:

SCHEDULE

The proposed schedule will commence Monday, July 2, 1990.

This proposal has been discussed with the Local Union Business Representatives.

Either the Company or Union reserves the right to return to the 5-day, 8-hour shift schedule by giving the other party 30 days advance written notice.

If you are in accord with the foregoing and agree thereto, please so indicate in the space provided below and return one executed copy of this letter to the Company.
